 RD, following a discussion that listed the public concerns, requested a vote from Cllr's about submitting an objection to TBC. RD was of the opinion that he was not in favour and not against the application. Two Cllr's voted against the application. 1 Cllr vote for and 1 was undecided. The Council would send their objections to TBC on the matter.
